**Jesse Colvin Begins '12 Counties, 12 Days' Tour**

**Perry Hall, MD – Maryland's 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District candidate Jesse Colvin will begin a road trip tour of all 12 counties in the 1<sup>st</sup> District on Monday. Colvin will spend a full day in each county, traveling from one to the next each day, starting October 1<sup>st</sup> and ending October 12<sup>th</sup>.**

"This election is about showing up — folks in this district have waited far too long for a representative who actually shows up and listens," Colvin said about launching the "12 Counties, 12 Days" tour. "We're going from Taneytown to Crisfield, and we'll be meeting with voters, small businesses, and community leaders."

The "12 Counties, 12 Days" tour will begin Monday in Carroll County, at the western most point of the 1<sup>st</sup> District. Below is Colvin's itinerary for the day.

2-3pm – **Monocacy River Run** (8295 Mumma Ford Rd, Keymar)

530-630pm – **Dinner with supporters at Greenmount Station** (1631 N Main St #4, Hampstead)

7-9pm – **Town Hall** (3300 Maple Grove Rd, Manchester)

On Tuesday (10/2), Colvin will spend the day in Baltimore County, followed by Harford County on Wednesday (10/3), Talbot County on Thursday (10/4), Kent County on Friday (10/5), Cecil County on Saturday (10/6), Caroline County on Sunday (10/7), Queen Anne's County next Monday (10/8), Dorchester County next Tuesday (10/9), Somerset County next Wednesday (10/10), Wicomico County next Thursday (10/11), and finally Worcester County next Friday (10/12).

Colvin and his campaign staff will be traveling through the 1st District in their new campaign RV, a 36-foot-long 2004 Fleetwood Bounder (picture attached). The 1<sup>st</sup> District is geographically the largest in the state of Maryland, covering over 3,653 square miles.
